

SUBJECT : Noise during radio recording

CONTENTS : During air checking, a beep sound (REC beat) may be recorded. When such a phenomenon is indicated, take the following countermeasures.


REMEDIES : 1. Noise during FM reception

- ① Attach a shield sheet round the X'TAL body on the control C.B (so that the body is wrapped).
- ② Solder a wire to the shield sheet. Solder the other end of the wire to the grounding land.
- ③ Change the resistor R353 from 2.2 k Ω to 1 k Ω .



2. Noise during AM reception

As shown in the drawing below, attach a shield sheet (20x30 mm) to the cassette holder side of the control C.B.



* Cut and use a shield sheet of the corresponding part indicated below in the specified size.
