**Subject:** Problem with the function "DELETE PROGRAMMING". Problem with the emphasis CD playback.

**Symptom:** 1. Problem with the function "DELETE PROGRAMMING".

When playing back the CD in the "DELETE PROGRAMMING" mode, If only one track is deleted, then the next track and all following tracks will not be played back. In case of several tracks are deleted, this phenomenon will not appear.

2. Problem with the emphasis CD play back.

When playback several emphasis CD's continuously, the second emphasis CD is played back without de-emphasis after the first emphasis CD has finished playing back.

**Solution:** Replace the microprocessor 7600 with the improved version.
