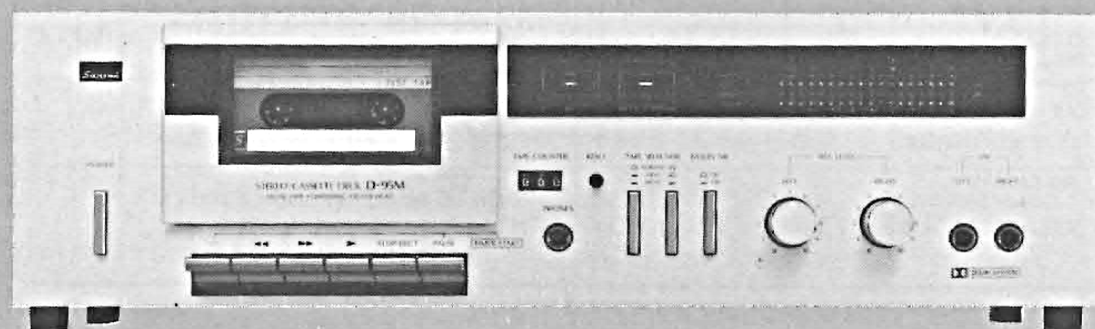

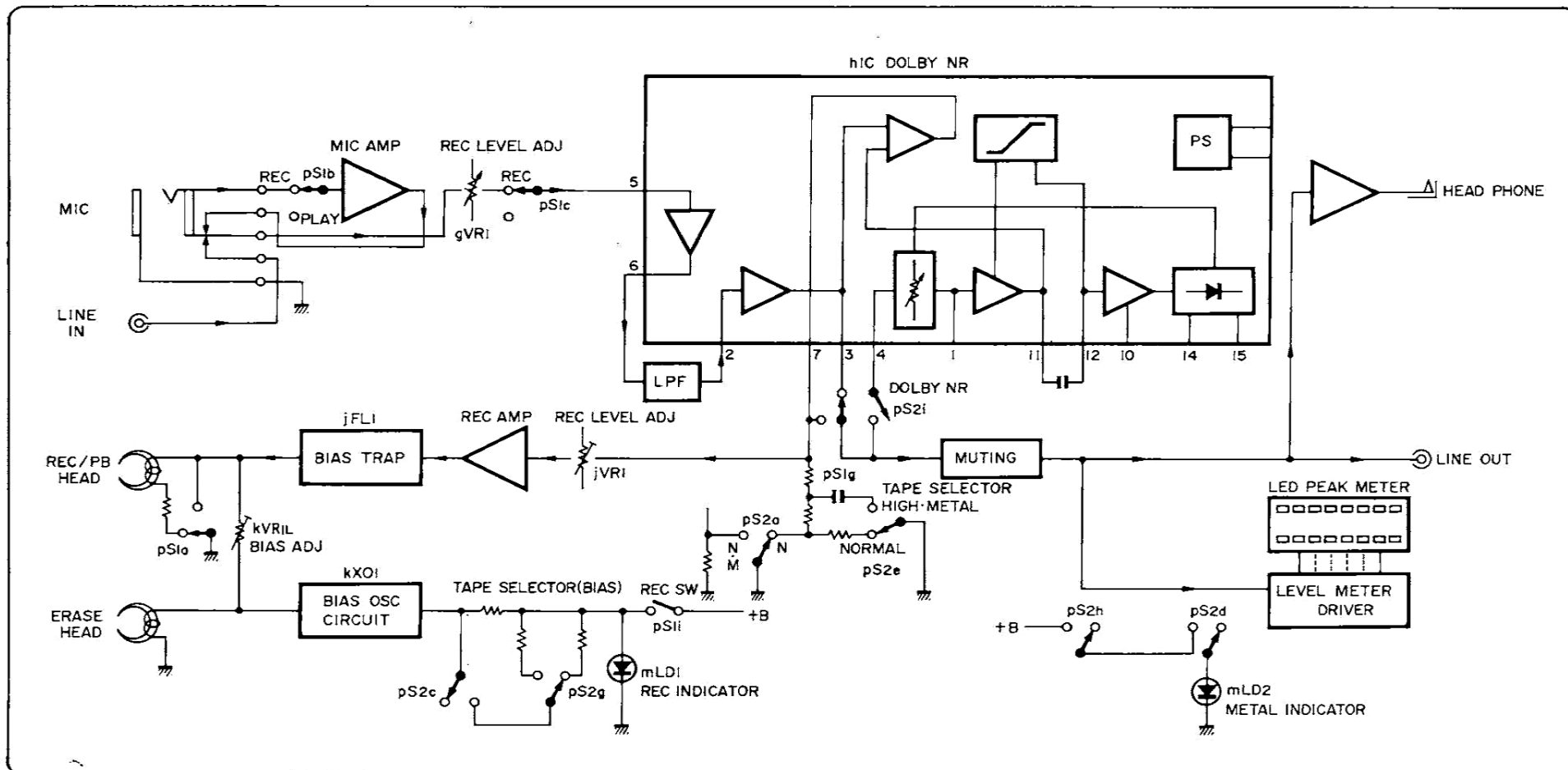

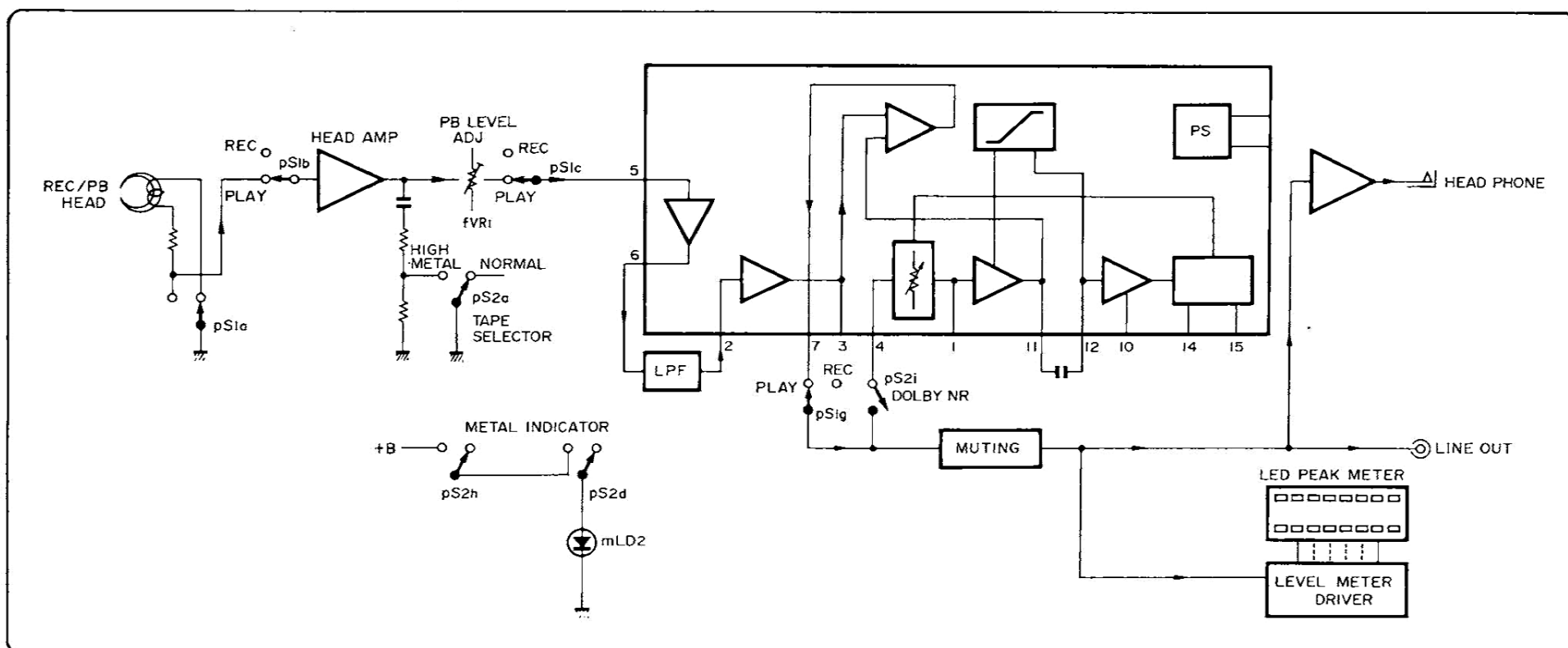

2. Connections are shown in Fig. 2-1.

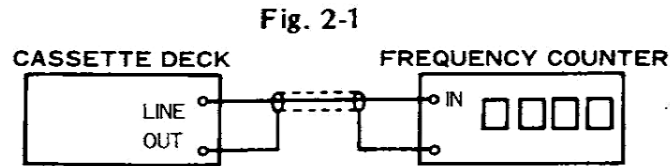
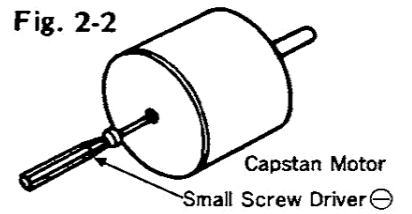

5. REPLACEMENT OF MAIN PARTS (See 4. Exploded View on page 5)

A. Replacement of mechanism chassis

- 1) Remove lid ass'y and lid base ass'y (See Front View on page 7)
- 2) Remove bonnet, bottom plate and front panel.
- 3) Cut the end of lines from mechanism chassis and their vinyl bands.
- 4) Pull out flexible wire.
- 5) Loosen 4 screws (5) (See Top View on page 7) fixing mechanism chassis.

B. Replacement of motor ass'y (47)

- 1) Remove bonnet, bottom plate and front panel.
- 2) Cut the end of line from motor.
- 3) Loosen one screw at input terminal to remove back panel.
- 4) Remove left and right side panels slowly.
- 5) Loosen 2 screws (3) at motor mounting plate (43) to take out it.
- 6) Loosen 3 screws fixing motor ass'y (47).

C. Replacement of capstan belt (51)

(See B. Replacement of motor ass'y)

- 1) Take out motor mounting plate (43).
- 2) Loosen 2 screws (3) fixing flywheel bearing plate (55) to take out it.

D. Replacement of counter belt (31)

- 1) Remove bonnet, lid ass'y and mechanism panel (62).
- 2) Take out counter belt (31) from the gap (between lead switch (88) and magnet of counter (62)).

Note: Pay attention not broken lead switch.

E. Replacement of rec prevention nail (26)

- 1) Remove bonnet, lid ass'y and mechanism panel (62).
- 2) Take off the end of spring (25) at rec prevention nail.
- 3) While widen a little of foundation, push squeeze the new nail.

Note: Pay attention not broken foundation of nail.

F. Replacement of idler arm ass'y (28)

- 1) Take out mechanism chassis from set.
- 2) Take out mechanism panel (62).
- 3) Loosen 3 screws (3) to remove side mechanism connection plate (61).
- 4) Take out E-type washer (13) at right side of cassette support (72).
- 5) Loosen 2 screws (3) fixing friction chassis (67) to remove it.
- 6) Loosen 2 screws (3) at motor mounting plate (43).
- 7) Loosen one screw (3) at side mechanism chassis (43) to remove it.
- 8) Loosen 2 screws (3) at flywheel bearing plate (55) to pull out capstan flywheel (54).
- 9) Loosen one screw (3) at head base holder plate (2).

Note: Pay attention not loose ball bearing.

- 10) Take off head base spring (4) from hook of play lever (90).
- 11) While pull idler arm ass'y (28) to the right, pick up right end of head base (5) and put it on idler arm (28).
- 12) Loosen 2 screws (27) and while move idler arm ass'y (28) slowly, remove sub mechanism chassis (48).

G. Replacement of take-up reel hub ass'y (105), supply reel hub ass'y (101), FF/REW arm ass'y (99) and FF belt (100)

- 1) Remove sub mechanism chassis (48) from main mechanism chassis.
- 2) Pull out 2 plastic tacks (114) to take out lock plate (85) (86).

Note: Pay attention not broken plastic tacks.

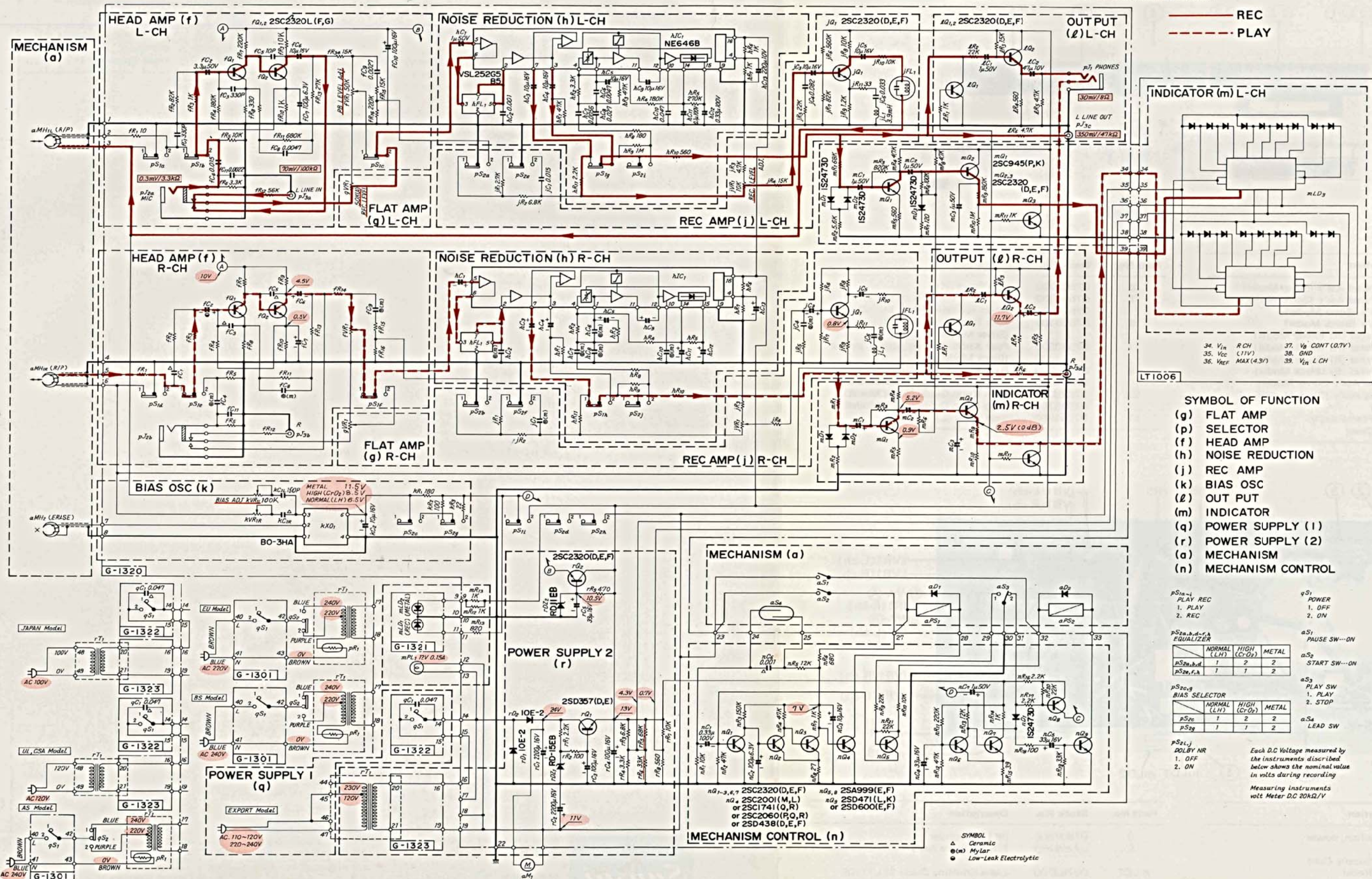
- 3) Take out play lever (90).
- 4) Take out FF lever (89), rec lever (87) and rew lever (88) further on the occasion of supply reel hub ass'y, FF/REW arm ass'y and FF belt.
 - a. Take out polyester washer (118) (119) on the occasion of take-up reel hub ass'y and supply reel hub ass'y.
 - b. Take out E-type washer (13) at arm ass'y (106) shaft on the occasion of FF/REW arm ass'y.
 - c. Pull out one gear of FF/REW arm ass'y (99) and take out E-type washer (13) at cue arm (93) on the occasion of FF belt (100).

H. Cleaning of take-up reel hub (105) and play idler (29)

- 1) Perform items 1) ~ 4) "Replacement of motor ass'y".
- 2) Loosen 2 screws at flywheel bearing plate (55) to pull out capstan flywheel (54).

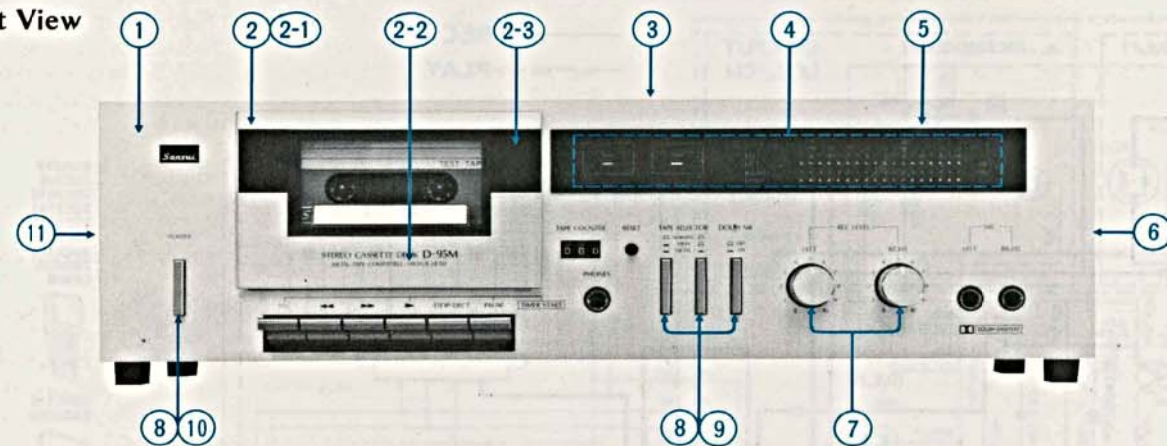

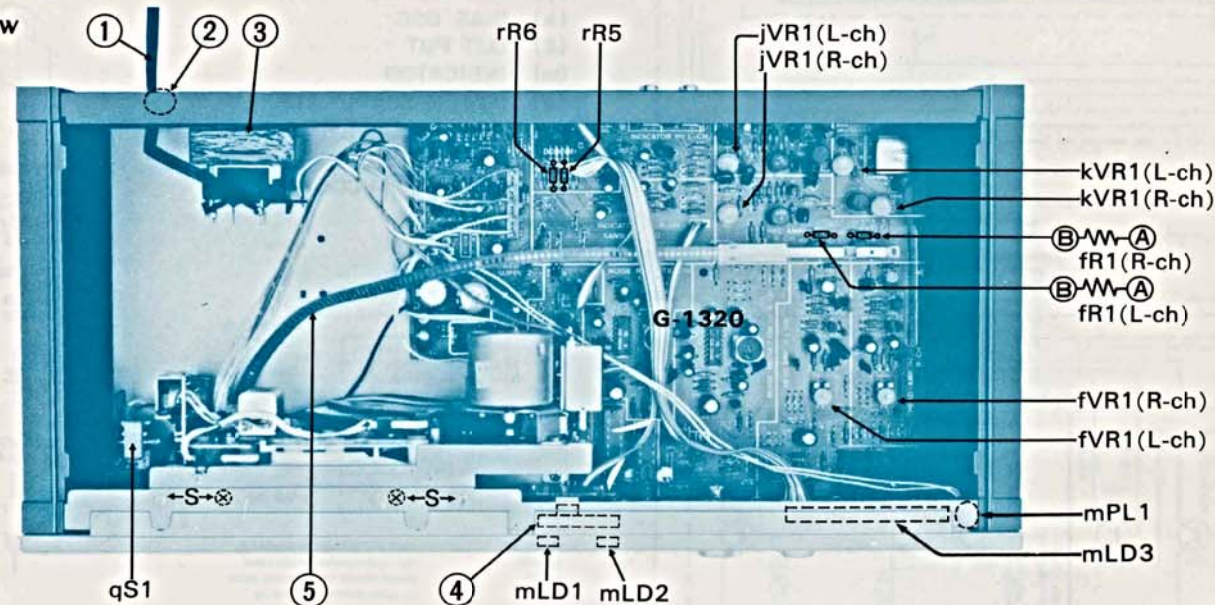

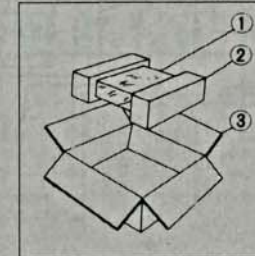
